


About the project

The converter station (topside) is being built in a shipyard in Dubai in the United Arab Emirates. The facilities and the power grid are scheduled to go into operation in 2027. This project in the field of renewable energies will help shape a better tomorrow and leads to considerable cost savings through the use of new

technology.
